#### **APS Virtual Workshop: Supporting Student Mental Health During the Campus Return**

The Fall 2021 semester will likely pose challenges for our students who will return to campus and be expected to continue to function amid the continued global pandemic and ongoing identity-based violence and oppression. This 60-minute virtual workshop, hosted by CAPS, shares practical ways faculty and staff can support student mental health in the return to campus, with additional focus on those with historically marginalized identities (e.g., Black, LGBTQ+, international). Learn ways to proactively attend to student mental health, promote inclusion and belonging, and respond to student
